Wars. Humanitarian Crises. Rumors of War. Breakdown of Whole Societies. What to do? A group I follow, the Franciscan Peace Group, sends a periodic newsletter. This week they recommend supporting a U.S. Department of Peacemaking, a bill introduced in the US House of Representatives. I would imagine it has approximately a zero percent chance of passing.

But isn't that the way of faith? Isn't that the way of the Spirit? You believe enough in the beloved community that you join with others to dream it into being. The abolitionists. The suffragists. The marchers in Selma and beyond.

You dream. You join with others who dream. And you make the path by walking. It is a bit like what congregations do.

And UUCOB has a great dream: An atheist, a Christian, and a Pagan walk into a church...we call that "Sunday." Or, "we need not think alike to love alike."

Back to the US Department of Peacemaking. Here is what the Franciscan Peace Fellowship writes about it: The Department of Peacebuilding Act of 2023 (H.R. 1111) was just introduced by Congresswoman Barbara Lee (CA-12). This legislation addresses the interconnection of all life and the intersection of peace, justice, equality, human rights, governments based upon rule of law, and planetary survival. The Peace Alliance invites us to tell our representatives to cosponsor H.R. 1111.
