

The League of Women Voters of Dare County will host a Zoom Hot Topic Session on Wednesday, March 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm on "The Immigrant Experience."

**Author (and UUCOB Member) Rosemary Rawlins** will introduce Sherita Grinter, the daughter of an immigrant from the Killing Fields of Cambodia, who immigrated to America in the 1980s. The audience will also meet Outer Banks resident, Aysha, who will speak about her more recent emigration from China due to the harsh treatment of the Uyghurs. Both participants will take questions from the audience.
