Rev. David's Quote of the Week

Margaret Fuller (1810 - 1850) was one of the leading lights of the Transcendentalist movement that had its birth among Unitarian writers and intellectuals. She wrote: "Reverence the highest, have patience with the lowest. Let this day's performance of the [most menial] duty be thy religion. Are the stars too distant? Pick up the pebble that lies at thy feet, and from it learn the all."

The realization that the highest truth lives in the most mundane of realities is a crucial part of our faith tradition's primary focus on this world and this life. We do not look to some "higher" reality to provide us with truth and meaning, but find them in the everyday existence we live each moment. Where do you encounter the wonders of the ordinary? If you think of menial tasks as sacred, does it change how you experience the simple necessities that confront us every day?


