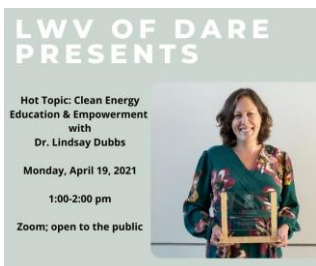
A note from the UU Justice Ministry of NC

Gallop Roofing is scheduled to replace our roof and windows. The dates planned to complete the work are Wednesday May 26th through Sunday June 6th.

IMPORTANT NOTE: During at least the first 3 days of the job, Wednesday, May 26th through Friday, May 28th, our contractor requests that no one is present on the premises to allow for the safe removal of the asbestos siding.
