



Rev. David's Quote of the Week

Holocaust survivor and psychologist Viktor Frankl (1905 - 1997) wrote: "We need to stop asking about the meaning of life, and instead to think of ourselves as those who are being questioned by life — daily and hourly. Our answer must consist, not in talk and meditation, but in right action and in right conduct. Life ultimately means taking the responsibility to find the right answer to its problems and to fulfill the task which it constantly sets for each individual. These tasks, and therefore the meaning of life, differ from person to person, and from moment to moment."

It's common to ask, especially in the wake of events like this week's school massacre in Texas, what "the meaning" of such a tragedy might be. Like asking the meaning of life, this is a question that assumes meaning is fixed by some outside influence or power, and that our task is to find it. Frankl's words remind us that it is up to us, instead, to make meaning from the events of our lives and our times. What action, what conduct will we undertake? What will we make this event mean?
