From the Desk of Rev. Roger



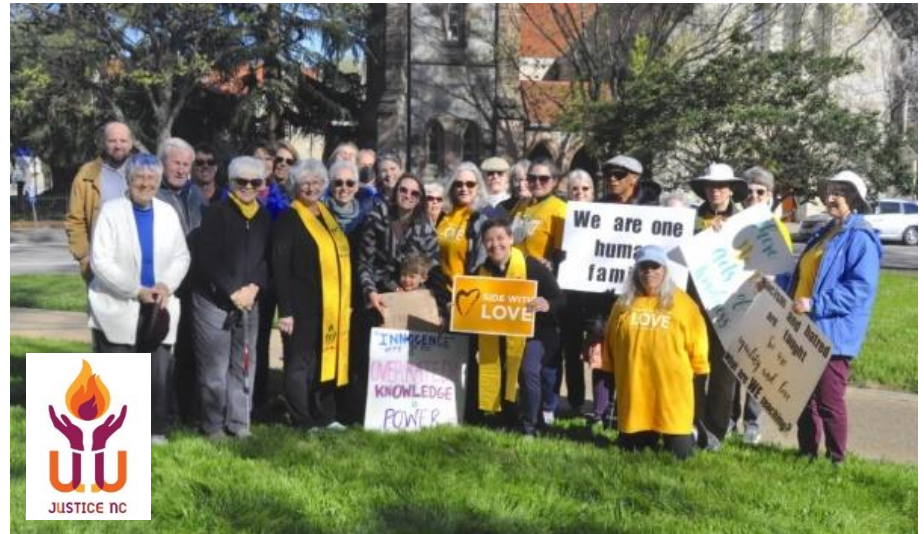
I am so glad that you are taking on a deep dive into the profound and timely idea of eco-spirituality. There are few things more important in our time.
